At this time, the Voorhees Township Public Schools will be closed from Monday, March 16, 2020 through the end of March. Decisions for resuming our regular school schedule will be updated as new information and guidance is given. The decision was made in consultation with the NJ Department of Health/Camden County Office of Health and Human Services. At this time, we will conduct school days remotely following the attached Remote School Days Plan. The collaborative efforts our amazing staff resulted in a comprehensive plan that will allow our students to continue their education during this unprecedented time.

The plan includes direct interaction between students and teachers each day. This will be a new learning experience for us all, and I know our cooperation and joint commitment to the plan will successfully get us through these trying circumstances.
