

Food Service Information for the 2022-2023 School Year

Over the past two years, the USDA made it possible to serve all students free breakfast and lunch through a waiver process. These waivers have not been extended into the 2022-2023 school year, therefore, all students will be at paid status for the upcoming school year.

Free and Reduced-Price Meal Application

To be eligible for Free or Reduced price school meals, an application must be completed. We encourage families to complete the Application for Free and Reduced-Price School Meals since it is also used to determine eligibility for P-EBT benefits, state funding, and other school benefits.

Please be aware, that any students who qualified for Free and Reduced-Price Meals in the 2021-2022 school year will be changed to paid status as of October 23, 2022 if a new application is not submitted to determine eligibility for the 2022-2023 school year.
