Scope of Work for Installation of Food Service Equipment

Voorhees Middle School - Kitchen

All bidders must visit job site prior to submitting their bids. Successful bidder must remove and dispose of two (2) existing fryers, two (2) existing ranges, one (1) 40 gallon kettle and one (1) 4 compartment steamer. New and existing equipment shall be arranged from right to left starting in trough area as follows: new Cleveland 30 gallon skillet, or equivalent, new Cleveland steamer, or equivalent, existing Garland steamer, existing Garland convection oven and new Garland convection oven, or equivalent (both convection ovens outside trough area).

Substitutions will be accepted only with prior written approval eight (8) days from bid due date in order that we may issue an addendum to all bidders.

All equipment to be totally installed which will include all duct work, plumbing, electric, hook ups, etc.

Successful bidder/installer will also be responsible for:

- 1. Receiving equipment from manufacturer, inspecting for any possible freight damages and delivering to job site.
- 2. Delivery, uncrating, verification that equipment delivered has all components and accessories as specified and setting in place.
- 3. Leveling of all equipment.
- 4. Complete hook up of all utilities, including all necessary duct work and plumbing, and verifying all utilities are correct voltage.
- 5. Test fire all equipment including cycling equipment to insure proper operation; i.e., pilots and burners are not disturbed by drafts from ventilation, equipment requiring floor drains are positioned correctly over drains.
- 6. Make all and any adjustments not covered by manufacturer's standard warranty; i.e., thermostat calibration, door adjustment, etc.

The food service operation expects one year parts and labor warranty and realizes manufacturer's warranty does not cover certain adjustments that are the responsibility of the bidder/installer, therefore, the aforementioned items have not been noted to insure the awareness of the bidder regarding these warranty issues. Any service bills during the first year of operation not covered by manufacturer's warranty will be the responsibility of the successful bidder/installer.

Voorhees Middle School Kitchen - Skillet, One (1) Required

Unit shall be Model No. SEL-30-T1 as manufactured by Cleveland Range Company, Cleveland, Ohio, or equivalent.

Skillet to have a 30 gallon full capacity rating to bottom of pouring lip and shall be mounted on an open frame design. A 5/8" stainless steel bead blasted cooking surface shall prevent warping and keep food from sticking. Pan shall be constructed of durable 12 gauge, 304 stainless steel with a 5/8" mild steel clad bottom plus a 1/16" stainless steel plate for even temperature distribution. Skillet to have a low 35" rim height for easy operation and cleaning.

To have high efficiency heating system with even heat distribution and a 12KW heating element. Skillet to be arranged for 460 volt, 3 phase operation. Electric thermostat to be adjustable having a range from 100° to 425° F. Provided with splash proof controls.

Provide easy to turn manual hand tilt with gallon/liter markings and 10° cooking feature which will tilt unit up 10° without the power being turned on. Cover shall be spring assist type with adjustable vent and full width handle.

Skillet to be complete with DPS-13, double pantry faucet with bracket, and Two (2) Dormont Manufacturing Company Model No. W5OBP2Q-48, 1/2" x 48" water connector (one hot and one cold).

Unit shall be provided with a two (2) year parts and labor warranty and free start up and demonstration.

Voorhees Middle School Kitchen - Convection Steamer, One (1) Required

Unit to be Model No. 24-CEA-IO as manufactured by Cleveland Range Company, Cleveland, Ohio, or equivalent. Shall be a two (2) compartment convection steamer SteamCraft® GeminiTM 10 with twin electric atmospheric steam generator having 32KW input, arranged for 460 volt, 3 phase operation.

Steam generator with automatic water fill on start up, automatic generator blow down, two (2) each 16.5KW fire bar heating elements shall be provided. Innovative PowerPak electric steam generator to have twin Vertical atmospheric design operating independently using two (2) 8KW fire bar heating elements per generator. To be constructed of 14 gauge stainless steel and shall have large 5 gallon generator reservoir for each compartment. To have two (2) fully insulated rear mounted independent steam generators.

Each steam cooking compartment is independently operated and controlled by a separate stainless steel steam generator, power on/off control levers and an exclusive, remote probe-type water level control. Each compartment shall have a capacity of five (5) 12" x 20" x 2-1/2" deep cafeteria pans.

Main power on/off switch to automatically fill generator with water and then start heating elements in generator. Instant steam stand by mode to hold generator at a steaming temperature to allow unit to start cooking instantly. Automatic generator drain to contain a "Water Jet" spray rinse drain cleaning cycle to keep drain clear. Separate from the generator for easy access there shall be an exclusive automatic probe for water level control containing a high velocity rinse cycle to eliminate mineral build up.

To have 14 gauge stainless steel compartment interior for compartment door, cavity and steam generator. Exclusive Brass Steam jets to produce a high velocity convection steam without fans. Coved corner design in cooking compartment to distribute heat evenly and is easy to keep clean. Creased top and bottom provided to enhance drainage. Cold water condenser for each compartment to maintain dry steam. Fully insulated cooking compartment for thermal efficiency to have removable stainless steel slide racks. Provided under lower compartment there shall be a condensate drip trough.

Shall have two (2) generator cleaning ports located on the outside, top of the unit. Generator cleaning indicator light located on the front of the unit to warn operator it is time to delime generator.

To have exclusive "Cool to the Touch" two (2) piece, compartment doors with free floating inner door and reversible gasket to provide an air tight seal. Slam/latch door latch mechanism to be stainless steel.

To be mounted NSF Certified 6" stainless steel legs with adjustable flanged feet for a 1" level adjustment. Unit shall be built to comply with applicable standards for manufacturers including UL, NSF, CSA, ETL and others. Provided with unit there will be a two (2) year parts and labor warranty, free start up and demonstration. Unit to be further provided two (2) Dormont Manufacturing Company No. W37BP2Q-48, water connectors.

Voorhees Middle School - Convection Oven, One (1) Required

Unit to be Model No. MCO-ES-20-S as manufactured by Garland Commercial Industries, Inc., Freeland, Pennsylvania, or equivalent. Unit to be a double deck electric convection oven arranged for 460 volt, 3 phase operation.

Unit to be provided with Master 200 solid state control with 150° to 500° temperature range and electromechanical timer. Shall have electronic spark ignition, including automatic pilot system with 100% safety shut off.

Oven interior dimensions shall be 29" wide x 24" high x 28" deep. Oven to have sealed "Muffle Oven" cavity construction, heavy gauge die formed steel with large cove corners for smooth laminar circulation of heated air radiating from heating elements. Porcelain enamel oven interior and rear baffle shall be provided. The heat control sensing element shall be encased in a steel guard for protection. Six (6) chrome plated, heavily constructed oven racks, with 13 position chrome rack guides to be provided. Oven chamber shall be provided with manually controlled climate vent system to regulate excess moisture.

To be provided with 60/40 doors, operated by an insulated handle, to open and close with ease. To have full length stainless steel positive door closure. Each door section to be provided with a double pane thermal window. Safety switch shall turn off fan when doors are opened.

Shall be provided with 3/4 h.p. self lubricating, sealed ball bearing type motor with thermal overload protection. To be provided with two (2) speed fan motors and 10.4KW rated electric elements operation per cavity. An s/s hinged panel shall be provided for each access.

Oven front, two (2) sides, top and legs shall be stainless steel. Shall be provided with a one (1) year parts and labor warranty and five (5) year limited door warranty, excluding window.

Garland convection oven shall be UL, CUL and NSF listed.

During the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:
