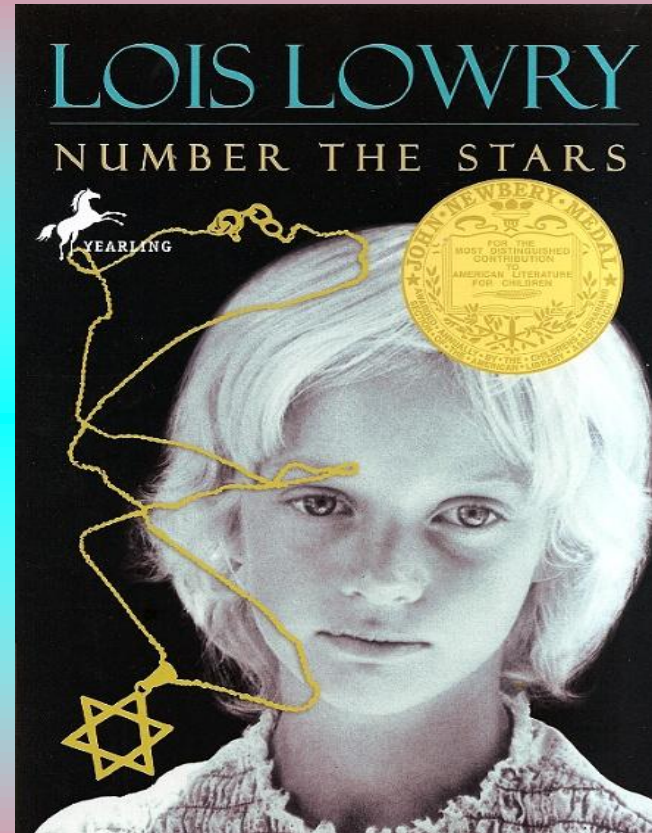


Number the Stars A-Z Booklet

Denmark

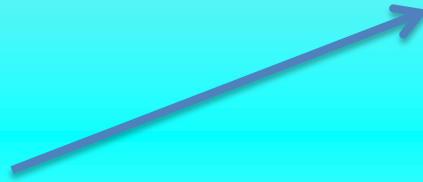
Denmark is where the entire story takes place. In Denmark, they go to Copenhagen and Gilleleje.

Lise Johansen

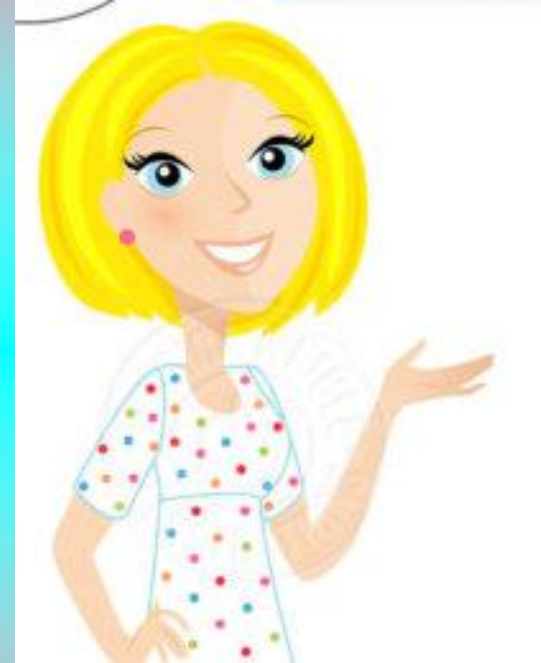
Lise Johansen is a part of the Johansen family. She was married to Peter Nelisen, but she died in a car accident.

Temporarily Losing Your Sense of Smell

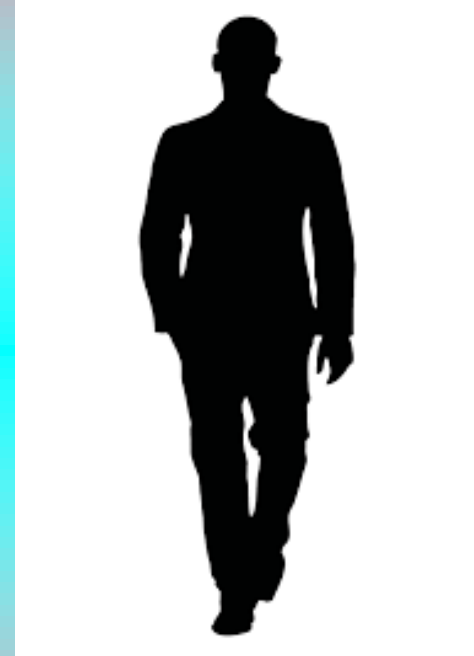
When the dogs smelled the handkerchief they lost their sense of smell temporarily. This happened because there were chemicals in the handkerchief that did this to them.
