

Kresson Print Book Borrowing Permission

I'm so excited to have students back in the library this fall! Your child will have the opportunity to borrow print books from the Kresson Library. Due to varying comfort levels during the pandemic, we are asking parents to complete this [Google permission form](#) permitting students to borrow books. You can also access this form through the Kresson Library page on the school website. Students will not be able to borrow books without this completed form on file.

Kresson Book Circulation Protocol:

- Students will select from an assortment of age appropriate books pulled by the librarian prior to class. They will not be able to browse the library shelves.
- Students will have the option of filling out a Google form menu prior to their scheduled time in order to request specific titles or genres. They will also be able to place holds on popular titles through our Destiny Catalog.
- Students in 2nd-5th grades will check out books using a touchless self-checkout system. 1st grade books will be checked out by the librarian.
- All returned books will be quarantined for at least 72 hours, as per [REopening Archives, Libraries, and Museums \(REALM\) Project](#) recommendations, then returned to the shelf.
- If a student's cohort is not at Kresson on library day, they may request books via the above mentioned procedures and they will be delivered to their classroom.
- Fully remote students may request books via the above mentioned procedures. They will be bagged and labeled with the student's name. Parents may pick them up from the Kresson vestibule library cart when notified.
