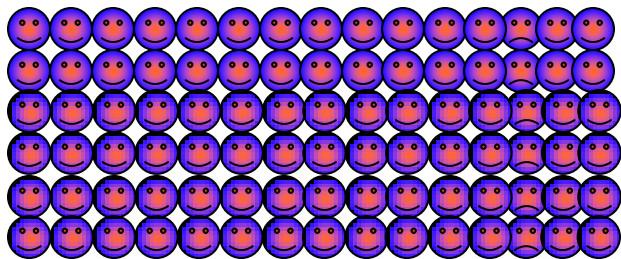
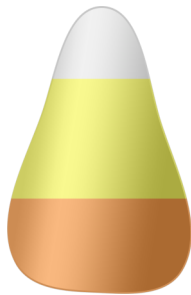


States of Matter

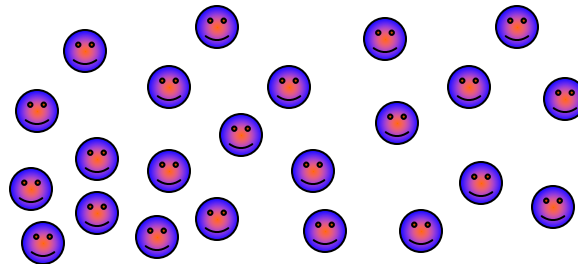
Solid

A solid has a definite shape, and it takes up a definite amount of space.



Liquid

A liquid does not have a definite shape, but it does take up a definite amount of space. It takes the shape of its container.



Gas

A gas takes the shape of its container. It does not have a definite amount of space.
