FEMA Reimbursement

(Federal Emergency Management Agency)

- In July 2020 the federal government declared the COVID-19 pandemic a 'category B disaster' and funding was made available for a variety of expenses related to the pandemic.
- The district submitted 4 project applications for reimbursement:

 UV Lighting purchase and installation
 Initial PPE & maintenance overtime
 Additional PPE, cleaning supplies and items for the re-opening of school
 Final PPE & touchless faucet/toilet hardware
- Initially project 1 was denied, project 2 and 4 were approved and project 3 was partially approved (final PPE only). The district received reimbursement from FEMA in the amount of \$97,707.31.
- In May 2022, we received word that additional funding was available and previously denied projects would be reevaluated. In August 2022, we submitted the requested information relating to project 1 and project 3. On September 14, 2022 we were notified that the two projects were now approved and an additional **\$599,875.23** was being processed for payment. Payments were received two days later.
