What is Title I/BSIP?

- ✍ District-wide supplemental instruction program
- ✍ Provides students with reinforcement in the areas of reading, math, and language arts
- ✍ It is not associated with special education

How is the Program Funded?

- ✍ Local/State Funds - Received Annually
- ✍ Federal Title I Funds Received Annually - through a federal grant prepared by the district

What are the School and District Policies?

- ✍ Title I District/School Involvement Board Approved Policies available on district website

How are students selected for participation?

- ✍ State and standardized assessment scores are below the minimum levels of proficiency
- ✍ Teacher recommendation
- ✍ Response to Intervention Team recommendation
- ✍ Student was enrolled in a program in another school district
- ✍ Parent request

What is the format of the program?

- ✍ Curriculum follows NJSLs
- ✍ Small group and/or in-class instruction
- ✍ Meet regularly according to established schedule
- ✍ Ongoing communication between homeroom teacher and BSIP teacher

How are parents kept involved?

- ✍ Receive BSIP progress reports sent 2nd and 4th marking periods
- ✍ Progress discussed at conference time
- ✍ Invited to attend Board Meetings and Parent Group Meetings

What are parent rights?

- ✍ All BSIP teachers are highly qualified
- ✍ Communicate with staff to make suggestions
- ✍ Take an active role in your child's education
