#### What is Title I/BSIP?

- ✓ District-wide supplemental instruction program
- ✓Provides students with reinforcement in the areas of reading, math, and language arts
- ✓It is not associated with special education

### How is the Program Funded?

- ✓Local/State Funds Received Annually
- Federal Title I Funds Received Annually through a federal grant prepared by the district

# What are the School and District Policies?

✓ Title I District/School Involvement Board Approved Policies available on district website

# How are students selected for participation?

- ✓ State and standardized assessment scores are below the minimum levels of proficiency
- ✓ Teacher recommendation
- Response to Intervention Team recommendation
- Student was enrolled in a program in another school district
- Parent request

#### What is the format of the program?

- Curriculum follows NJSLS
- ✓Small group and/or in-class instruction
- Meet regularly according to established schedule
- ✓Ongoing communication between homeroom teacher and BSIP teacher

#### How are parents kept involved?

- Receive BSIP progress reports sent 2nd and 4th marking periods
- Progress discussed at conference time
- ✓Invited to attend Board Meetings and Parent Group Meetings
