COVID-19 Protocols

We will continue to align the practices of the District with guidelines from the Center for Disease Control (CDC), New Jersey Department of Health, and Camden County Health Department. The current protocols for the District will be posted on the District's website by September 6, 2022.

Chronic Absenteeism

Regular attendance is primary to promoting the academic success of students. The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) considers a student chronically absent if the student misses more than 10% of the total enrollment days. Therefore, students enrolled in the District for the entire year are considered chronically absent if they are absent for more than 18 days. Research has determined that students are negatively impacted when absences become a pattern. It may not seem like a concern if a student misses just one or two days of school a month, but over time, those days of lost learning can lead to years of academic struggles and challenges beyond the classroom.

Parent Monthly Virtual Workshops

I am pleased to announce that over 200 parents and guardians participated in the Parent Monthly Virtual Workshop Survey.
