NJ Department of Health as of January 19, 2022.

Students who are considered close contacts in the following groups are to be excluded from school:

- ⇒ Age 12 or older who completed the primary series of a recommended COVID-19 vaccine but have **not** received a recommended booster shot when eligible.
- \Rightarrow Persons who are not fully vaccinated.

CDC is updating the recommendation for when many people can receive a booster shot, shortening the interval from 6 months to 5 months for people who received the Pfizer Vaccine. At the current time, this guidance is for everyone 12 years and older. If your child is eligible for the booster and has not received it yet then they will have to quarantine if they are deemed a close contact at school.
